Rotary Health Park Banners: There is one location available at the Pat & Jim Brockenborough Rotary Health Park at the corner of 13th and Martin Luther King Jr. Drive. Banners must be constructed of heavyweight, water-resistant fabric. The size of banner is restricted to **3' x 15'** and must have wind slits.

Broadway and Jefferson Banners: There are 25 pole banner locations on Broadway and 21 on Jefferson. Banners must be constructed of heavyweight, water-resistant fabric. The size of banners is restricted to **thirty (30) inches by eighty (80) inches** in order to fit the installed brackets. The banner shall be constructed to fit the mounting hardware where the banner can be mounted by slipping the banner arms through the sewn, looped top and bottom of the banner. The loops must be three (3) inches in order to slip over the banner arms. The Figure below illustrates the proper construction and mounting. The design shall be the same on both sides of the banner.
